some Old Testament "broken people"

◆ Adam & Eve loss of the Garden, then Abel's murder

◆ Jacob believing that Joseph was dead

◆ Joseph forgotten in prison for two years

♦ Israel under a ruthless Pharaoh
♦ Moses missing the Promised Land
♦ Israel a terrible cycle in Judges

Naomi famine, exile, death of her familySamuel over King Saul's pride & downfall

◆ David over Absalom's betrayal and death

♦ the Prophets especially Jeremiah

◆ Job & Solomon suffering in body and/or mind

♦ many Psalms called Psalms of Lament

background notes on Luke 7:11-17



- ♦ touching a coffin brings "defilement"
- the widow could now be an outsider
- ♦ the Luke 4 "Jubilee" is arriving

a broken mind a broken body a broken voice a broken vision

- ◆ the initiative by Jesus
- ♦ the compassion in Jesus
- ♦ God's visitation through Jesus

- ◆ I believe that I am welcome, even me
- ◆ I will speak out all of my lament
- ◆ I will receive his mercy and blessing
